COVID-19 UPDATE

Effective Sunday, May 3, 2020 exhibiting symptoms is no longer a prerequisite for testing at Community-Based Testing Sites.

In order to be eligible for testing, individuals must be current New Jersey residents. However, the **highest priority** for testing will be given to health care workers and workers in congregate living settings, and symptomatic first responders, as well as to asymptomatic NJ residents who have been in close contact with someone else who has tested positive. **Community-Based Testing Sites are for current New Jersey residents and members of New Jersey law enforcement agencies.**

Effective Monday, May 4th, the Union County Covid-19 Drive-Through Test Center will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The Union County COVID-19 Drive-Through Test Center is a free service available to Union County residents who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms. It is also free to first responders and front-line health workers who are experiencing symptoms, regardless of their place of residence.
